We have been developing our fine motor skills using small bricks and lolly sticks to make bridges for the tiny dinosaurs.

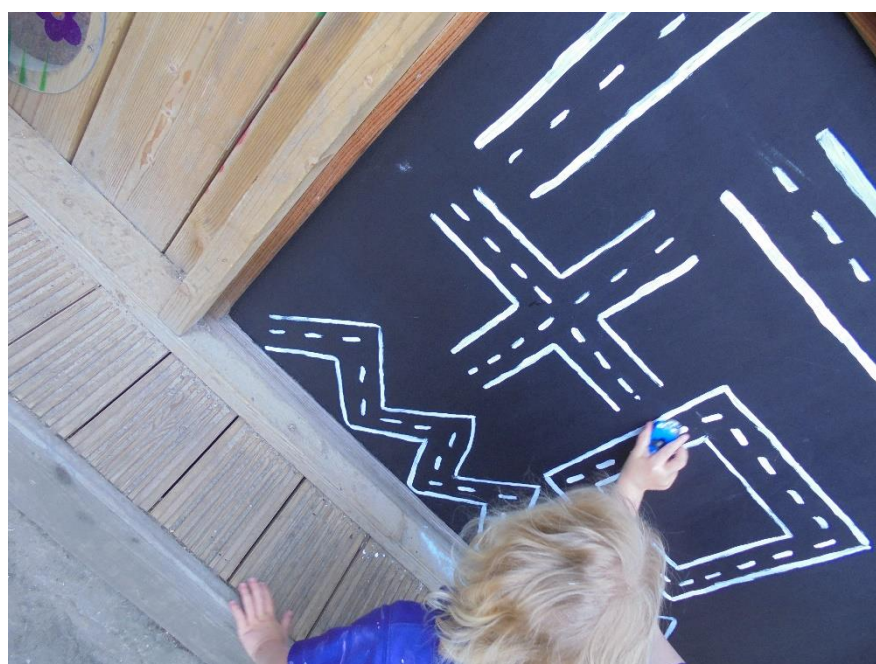
Can you make some bridges at home for your toys?





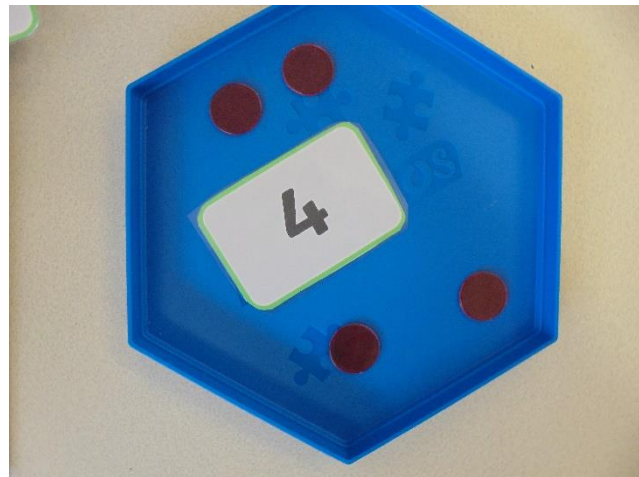
We have been working to develop our balancing skills.
