Was Mary I a successful monarch?

Mary I of England (r. 1553–1558) is often considered less successful due to her efforts to restore Roman Catholicism and the persecution of Protestants. Her marriage to Philip II of Spain was unpopular, and her reign is remembered for economic challenges and social unrest. However, her five-year rule did bring stability to some extent and was followed by the long and prosperous reign of her sister, Elizabeth I.
