

Peek at the Week



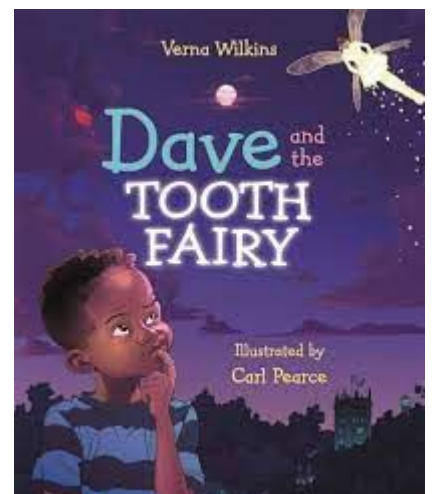
Dave and the Tooth Fairy

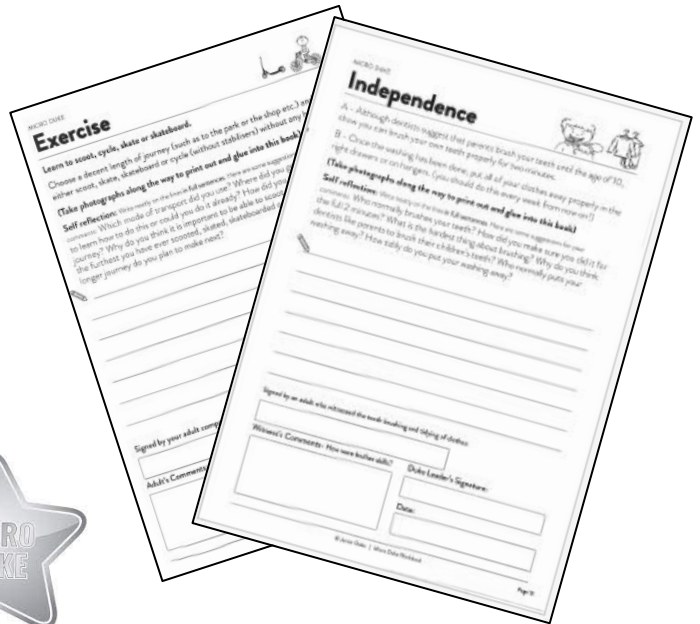
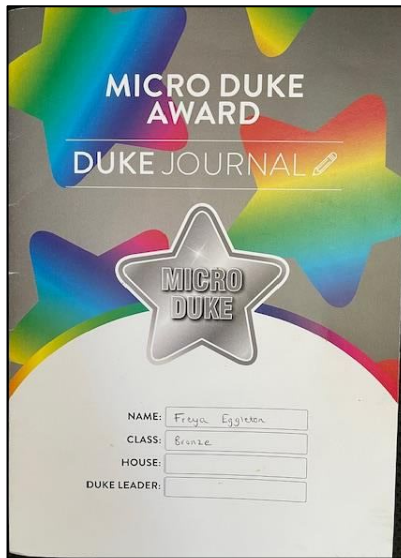
We discussed why we have teeth. What are they used for? The children shared their stories about how they clean their teeth and how often. Many of the children have already visited the dentist so they were able to tell us all about the big comfy chair that goes up and down. And finally we talked about the kind of food that we need to eat small amounts of and which foods help to keep our teeth strong and healthy.

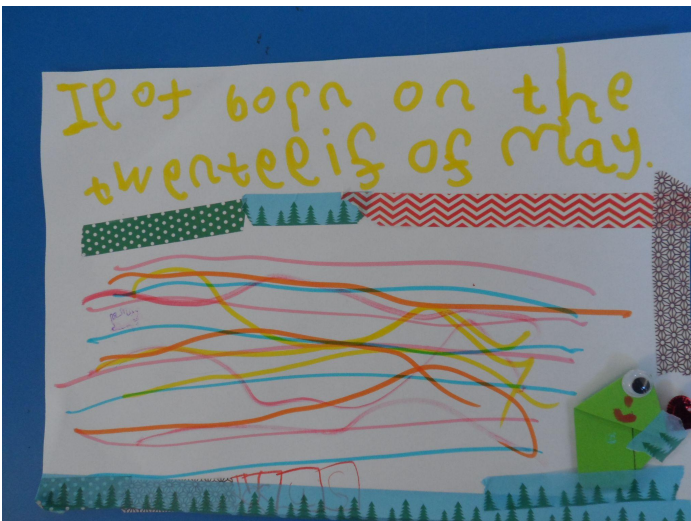

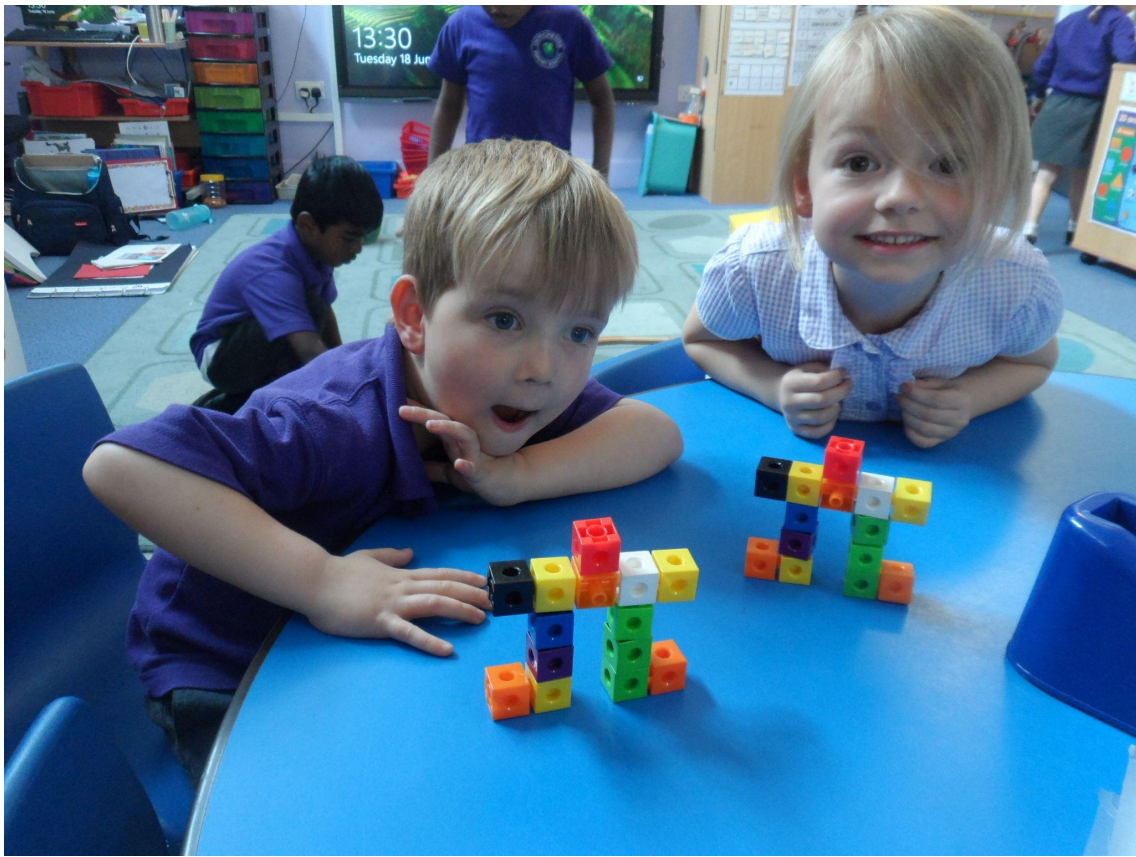
