Enquiry Question of the week

Each week we will post an Enquiry Question from the week's learning alongside the answer we would expect. Ask your child the question and see how close your child is to answering the question fully. If they are finding it tricky, break down the answer together and see if they can work on learning more at home.

A: Many of the activities we do use water, the most wastage comes from leaving taps on and from not thinking about how to best save water.
