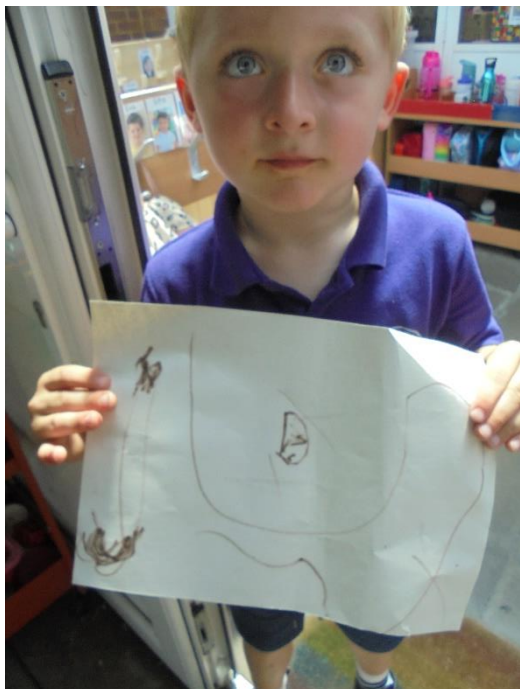
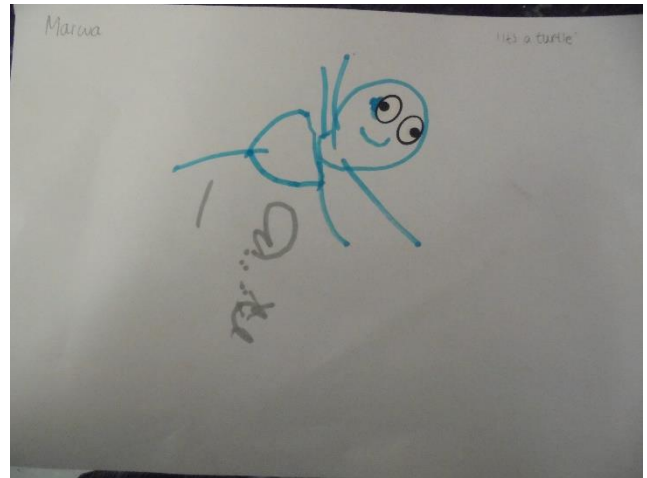
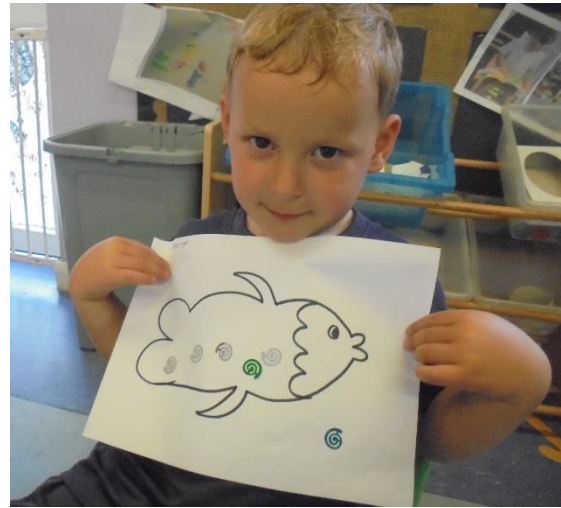

Please show your child these pictures and encourage them to talk about them.

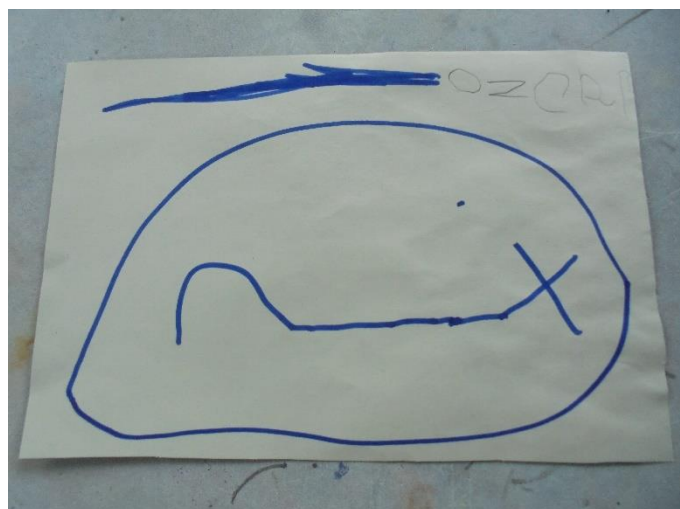




We have been making sea creatures using different materials.
