Enquiry Question

What is an OS map, what are its features/symbols and what is it used for?

Perfect Answer:

An OS Map is a scale topographical map that can be used to navigate effectively across a given region. To prevent the map being too cluttered with words, symbols are used for many common features like: parking, picnic area, toilets, place of worship, etc. Every map comes with a legend, which is a key so you know
