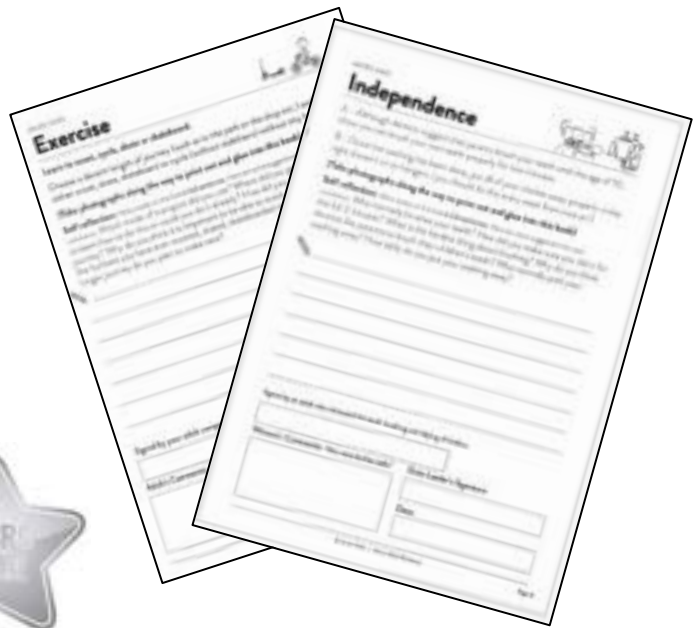
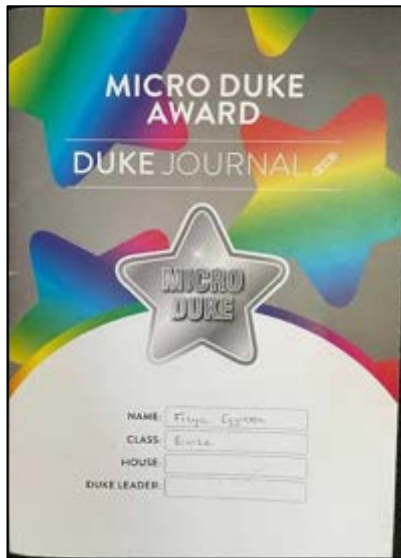


Bocketts Farm Park
