

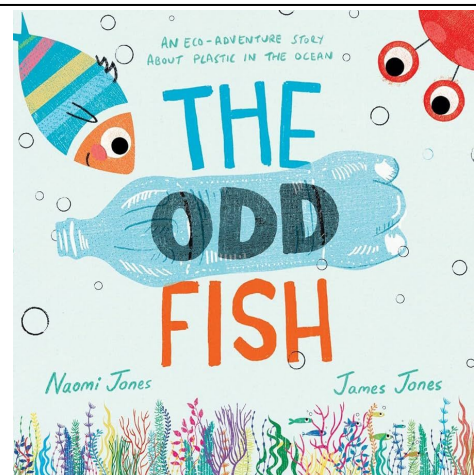
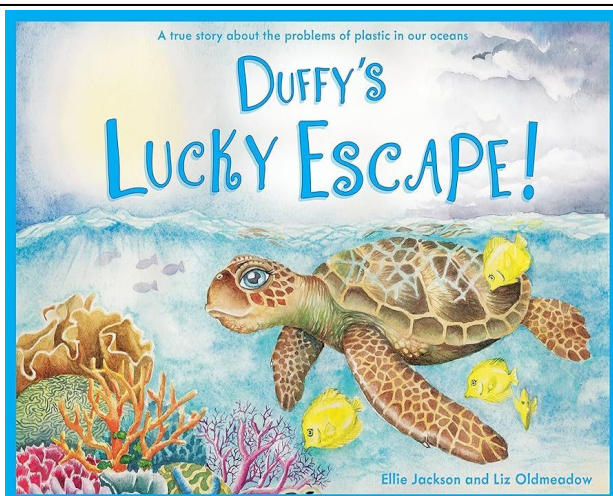
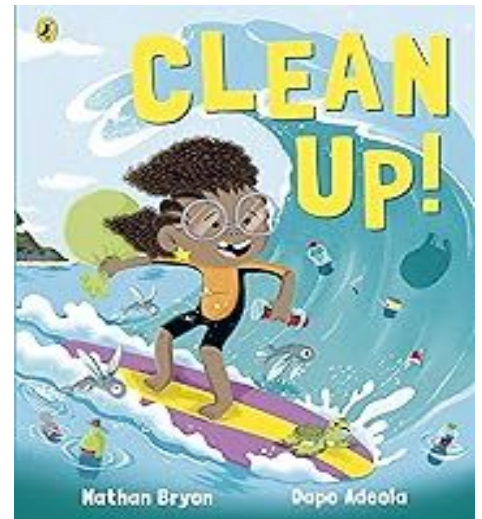
Peek at the Week

Big shout out to the Infant Choir this week. They sang in front of Reception, KS1 and Year 3 on Wednesday Morning! They haven't stopped singing since :-)



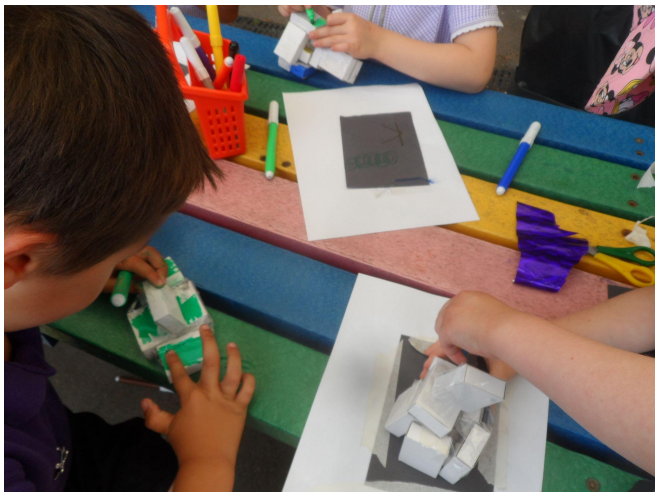
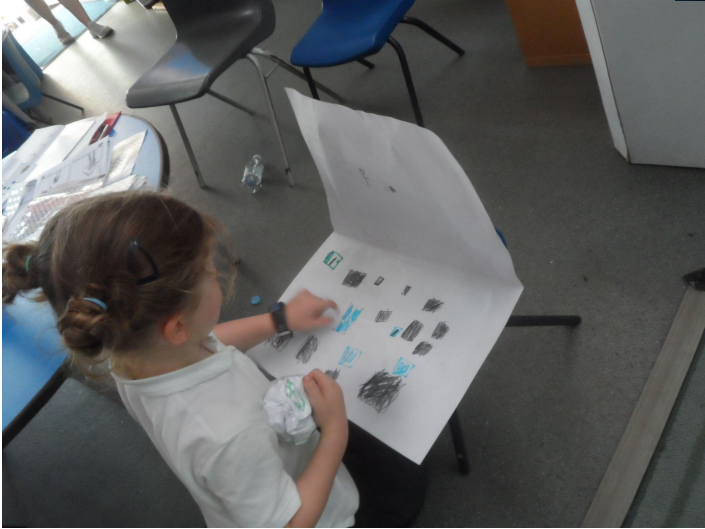
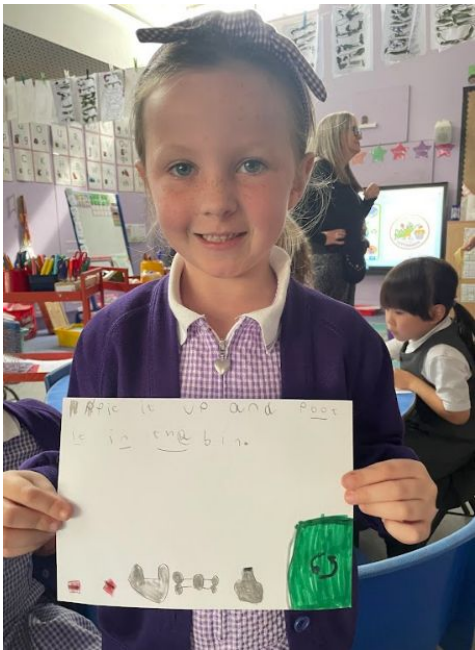
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We are very proud of the children who achieved their Micro Duke Awards this week. They had a special presentation on Wednesday with Mr Dennis and the parents attended.



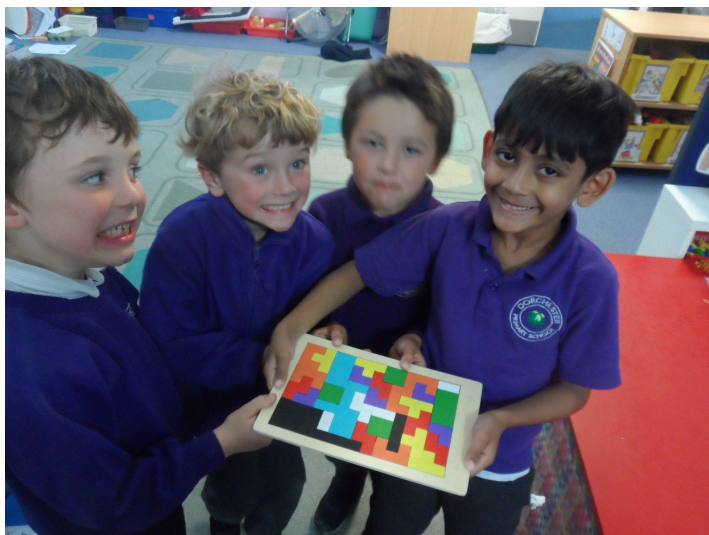
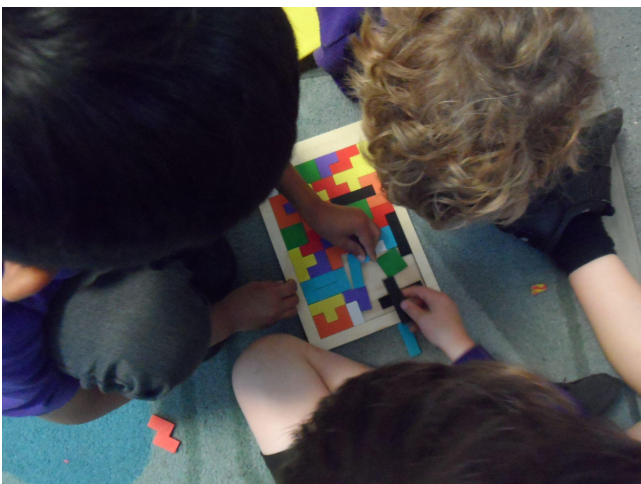
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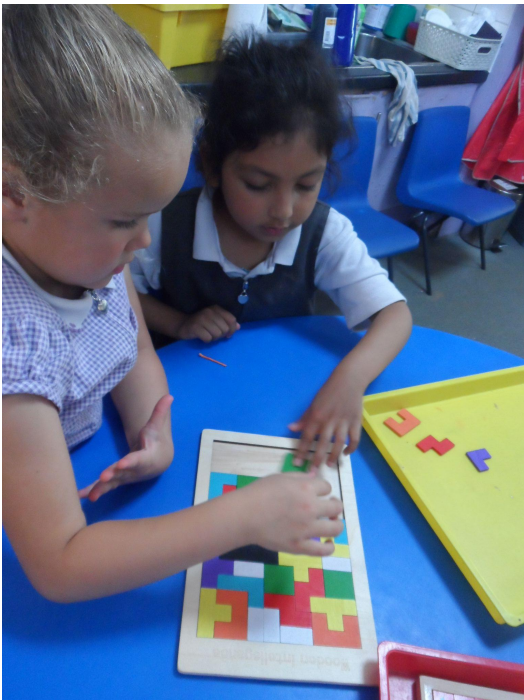
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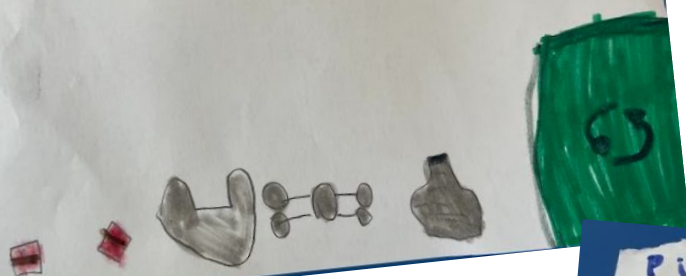
